

2. Eligibility

Eligibility and priority for the residency of the TIGP Student Dormitory are stated below, respectively:

2.1. a matriculated TIGP student – when availability is low, the order of priority for residency is stated respectively as follows:

- (1) First year foreign students and physically challenged students;
- (2) First year local students whose permanent address is more than 20km from the Academia Sinica;
- (3) Second year foreign students;
- (4) Second year local students whose permanent address is more than 20km from the Academia Sinica;
- (5) Third year foreign students;
- (6) A TIGP student whose status is excluded as stated above;
- (7) Annexes for exceptional case.

2.2. when rooms are not fully occupied, vacancies will be open for application to the non-TIGP PhD students (both foreign and local) working in Academia Sinica; the order of priority for residency is stated respectively as follows:

- (1) a PhD student who's advisor is amongst the TIGP faculty
- (2) other PhD students working in Academia Sinica

2.3. Four rooms are reserved as guest rooms for TIGP-affiliated exchange students.

2.4. Maximum period of occupation – Students with status as indicated in 2.1. (1)-(4) are entitled to a maximum period of occupation for two years. Other students will be granted only one year residency. This policy will be assessed and modified by the Residence Committee when a shortage of room occurs.

★3. An application will **NOT** be considered when the applicant is found to be:

3.1. infected with **Legal Contagious Diseases** listed below. (For further information, please visit the CDC website at <http://www.cdc.gov.tw>). Should an infection occurs after residency is granted, the Residence Committee reserves the right to re-evaluate or withdraw the residency, subjected to the seriousness of the issue.

3.2. diagnosed as psychologically unstable.

3.3. with severe criminal records
